- Be an advocate for parents perspectives in your cluster and a conduit for two-way communications
- Leading by example to build positive and respectful relationships within school communities and the wider diocese
- Providing input into planning and implementation of DPC activities to foster and promote the engagement of all parents
- Support the CSP as an advocate for Catholic education in the local and political arenas, in collaboration
 with the CSO, CCSP NSW/ACT and the CEC/NSW, including with regards to the funding of Catholic
 schools
- Engaging with the Catholic Schools Office in regular consultation about parent partnerships;


